Tis the season for safety!

CANDLES -- On average, 20 home candle fires are reported per day, peaking in December and January. . . Look for alternatives!*

LIGHTS & TREES	
	Check for broken or frayed cords or lights before you string. Use lights with UL label. Hook 3 strings together, max. Artificial tree? Check for "Flame Resistant" label. Buy LED holiday lights — they last longer and are safer. Be careful not to push a staple or drive a nail through cord. Unplug lights and outdoor lighting before leaving the house or going to bed.
CC	RDS & OUTLETS
	Extension cords are meant for temporary use. They carry power even when the appliance or lights are turned off so unplug and store when you're done using them.
	Use the right size cords and don't overload outlets! Outdoors, use a cord labeled "Outdoor/Exterior."
	Outdoors, use a 3-prong extension cord and plug into a grounded outlet (GFI outlet).
	Outdoors, keep cords out of water including sprinklers; warn your gardeners!
	Indoors, uncoil extension cords completely before using.
	Never to use an extension cord with a space heater.
	Never run extension cords under rugs.
	Does your cord feel hot? Something's wrong. Stop using it.
